[No solid foods for 4 hours prior to exam. Drink at least 1 quart of water during the day of your exam unless otherwise instructed by your physician. Drink the entire content of liquid that you received for this exam 2 hours prior to your scheduled appointment time.]

ULTRASOUND

Please allow 30 minutes to 1 hour for all ultrasound exams.

All exams below require:

[Finish drinking 24 ounces of water 1 hour before your appointment time. Please arrive with a very full bladder.]

DEXA - Bone Density Scan

No preparations are required

- Small, thin frame**
- Family history**

DIAGNOSTIC X-RAY

Please allow 1 hour for all exams unless otherwise noted.

- Arthrogram** [No Prep]
- Esophagram** [Light meals are permitted up to 2 hours before your exam.]
- Upper Gastrointestinal Study – UGI** [Nothing by mouth after 10:00 p.m the night before the study. Chewing gum and smoking are not allowed.]
- Small bowel follow through – SBFT** [Nothing by mouth after 10:00 p.m. the night before the study. Chewing gum and smoking are not allowed. The length of this exam is determined by how quickly or slowly your body passes the barium through to the large bowel. Please allow 1 – 6 hours for this exam.]
- Barium Enema** [The preparation for the barium enema begins the day before your scheduled appointment time. You will be given a prep kit by your doctor or you will be asked to pick one up at Longview Radiologists. It is very important you follow all the instructions in the prep kit.]
- IVP** [The preparation for the IVP begins the day before the exam. You will be given a prep kit by your doctor or you will be asked to pick one up at Longview Radiologists. Follow the instructions in your prep kit very closely. Please allow a minimum of 1-2 hours for the exam.]
